Home Learning

This week in Reception

Phonics: This week we have learnt the sounds 'g, o, c and k'. We have continued blending letter sounds using sounds we have learnt so far to read words. We have also learnt our first tricky word 'is'. We recognised that the 's' is making a 'z' sound.

Maths: This week we have been creating patterns visually and using actions/sounds. We have really enjoyed reading the story 'We are going on a bear hunt' and creating movements to match repeat words in the story.

Topic: In topics lessons this week we have been using the book 'Only one you'. We have discussed what the word 'unique' means and celebrated our differences. Thank you to those children that have brought in a photograph of their family to share with their class.

Phonics:

The children have enjoyed learning their phonemes this week. When you are out and about encourage your child to spot any of the letters we have learnt so far. Look out for 'g, o, c and k'

The sound cards 'g, o, c and k' will be in their book bags this week to use at home to recap their learning.

Reading:

Maths suggestion.

Can you go on a walk to find natural objects? Can you use these objects to create a pattern?



Next week in Reception

Maths: Next week the children will explore numbers 1, 2 and 3. They will be matching verbal number names to numerals and quantities. The children will be encouraged to find different representations of 1, 2 and 3 in the classroom environment.

Topic: The children will be learning about Diwali. They will take part in Diwali-themed activities which will introduce them to a different culture, while supporting key areas of their learning such as communication, creativity, and understanding of the world.

Phonemes we will be focusing on this week in school -



Pronunciation Phrase - ck

Open your mouth into a little smile; make your tongue flat and move it up towards the top of your mouth to say **ck ck**

Digraph (ck) -
two letters, one sound



Pronunciation Phrase - e

Open your mouth wide and say **eee**



Pronunciation Phrase - u

Open your mouth wide and say **uuu**



Pronunciation Phrase - r

Show me your teeth to make a **rrrrr** sound **rrrrr**

We will be orally blending words. Can you hear the phonemes in these words? Can you listen and then repeat the word?

s - o - ck

p - a - ck

p - e - t

m - u - d

r - e - d

d - u - ck

We will be practising tricky words. Can you spot the tricky part of the word?
