Home Learning

This week in Reception

Phonics: This week we have learnt the sounds 'h, f, l and b'. We have continued blending letter sounds using sounds we have learnt so far to read words and we have learnt the tricky word 'the'.

Maths: This week we have continued learning about numbers 1, 2 and 3. We have been learning to use the language 1 more and 1 less when singing songs.

Topic: In topics lessons this week we have been learning about people that help us with a particular focus on the fire brigade. We have learnt about how to stay safe on bonfire night and created firework pictures using different mediums.

Phonics:

The children have enjoyed learning their phonemes this week. When you are out and about encourage your child to spot any of the letters we have learnt so far. Look out for 'h, f, l and b'

The sound cards 'h, f, l and b' will be in their book bags this week to use at home to recap their learning.

Next week in Reception

Maths: Next week, we will be learning about triangles and circles. We will be looking at the features of these shapes and create shape pictures. We will also be learning some prepositional language like 'under, over, in and on' to describe the position of objects

Topic: In topics lessons, we will be learning about Remembrance Day and how events have happened in the past and why we remember them. We will also be reading the book 'Tidy' to explore the changes that happen to our environment during Autumn.

Phonics: In phonics lessons next week, we will be learning the digraphs ss ff ll and the new phoneme j and the tricky word 'as'

Focus - Phonemes ff / ll / ss / j

Phonemes we will be focusing on this week in school -



Pronunciation Phrase - ff

Open your lips a little; put your teeth on your bottom lip and push the air out to make the sound **ffff ffff**

Digraph (ff) -
two letters, one sound



Pronunciation Phrase - ll

Open your mouth a little; put your tongue up to the top of your mouth, behind your teeth, and press **llll**

Digraph (ll) -
two letters, one sound



Pronunciation Phrase - ss

Show your teeth and let the s hiss out **ssssss**

Digraph (ss) -
two letters, one sound



Pronunciation Phrase - j

Pucker your lips and show your teeth use your tongue as you say **jjj**

We will be reading and writing words. Can you spot segment and blend these words and spot this week's phonemes?
