Home Learning

This week in Reception

Phonics: In phonics this week, we have consolidated our knowledge of sounds and tricky words that we have learnt previously.

Maths: This week we have continued to learn about numbers 1-5. We have been using objects to identify what is *one more* or *one less* than given numbers.

Topic: WOW! We have had such an exciting week! We made our own bread, which we thoroughly enjoyed! We also tried different types of bread that originate from other countries.

Continue to build your confidence in counting to 5 using objects around your house.

Next week in Reception

Maths: In maths lessons, we will be exploring the composition of numbers 4 and 5. The children will be learning how these numbers can be made in different ways through practical activities and play.

Topic: In topics lessons, we will be reading the story 'Grumpy Badger's Christmas'. We will be thinking about the importance of kindness and friendship and how we can demonstrate this in our classroom and at home.

Phonics: In phonics lessons next week, we will be consolidating our knowledge of phonemes and diagraphs already learnt and practising our blending skills to help us read words.

Reminders

- **P.E Kit**
